## Down Deaths

Abortion for children with Down syndrome is common world-wide. Iceland is attempting to “eradicate” Down syndrome by aborting every incident in their country.

In Ohio, the legislature passed and the Governor signed into law, specific limits which will disallow any abortion which is aimed at an unborn Down syndrome child.

Quickly, the [ACLU filed a lawsuit](#) on behalf of Cleveland abortion provider, Preterm. NARAL Pro-Choice America and Planned Parenthood have come out in support of Preterm. Their objection is based on discrimination to those seeking abortion.

While pretending to defend women, they openly discriminate against health care workers by working to force them to participate in abortion.

Their support can only be based on their intention to defend abortion for any reason, independent of the life of the unborn child.

## Indiana Law

Indiana has passed a law which bans abortion based solely on a child’s disability, race, or sex. [Planned Parenthood filed suit](#) and the Federal District Court stopped the law from going into effect.

The U.S. Court of Appeals for the 7<sup>th</sup> District is scheduled to hear the case.

ADF Senior Counsel Denise Burke said, “Nothing is medically necessary or constitutionally protected about an abortion that is committed simply because a child has Down syndrome or isn’t the desired race or sex. The fact that Planned Parenthood is opposing a law like Indiana’s tells you what America’s number one abortion supplier really cares about.”

## Public Opinion

[A Marist poll, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus](#), *American’s Opinions on Abortion*, provides some interesting results. For example, over 60% of voters want significant restrictions on abortion.

Very significant also is the wording of the questions. They do not lead the respondent, but leave all response options open.

## Euthanasia
