Assisted Suicide

Non-consensual

Alex Schadenberg, Euthanasia Prevention Coalition, [describes a case](#) of a Dutch woman experiencing dementia, who had signed an advanced directive that she wanted euthanasia. However, she resisted vigorously when the doctor tried to administer the lethal drugs.

She was physically restrained by her family and then injected by the doctor.

The Dutch Supreme Court approved the doctor’s actions. They affirmed it is not necessary to confirm the patient/signatory still wanted euthanasia.

This can only be described as non-consensual assisted suicide. And, it means the Dutch are one giant step closer to non-consensual assisted suicide for those who have no previous advanced directive and do not want to be euthanized.

Far-fetched, not so. Germany did it secretly but with governmental approval. The Dutch are but a short step away from declaring it legal.

Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists [RCOG)

“[RCOG](#) guidelines for feticide state: ‘Where a decision to abort a pregnancy after 21 weeks and 6 days is taken, feticide should be routinely offered...in cases where...the abortion is not for fetal abnormality and is being undertaken after 21 weeks and 6 days of gestation, failure to perform feticide could result in a live birth and survival, which contradicts the intention of the abortion.’”

Party Differences

Do you know where the political parties stand on abortion?

On page 33 of the [Democratic Party Platform](#), under the title, *Securing Reproductive Health, Rights, and Justice*, is found party support for abortion on demand and repeal of the Hyde Amendment, and on page 17, under the title, *Securing Reproductive Health, Rights, and Justice*, the intent to pass the Equal Rights Amendment, which will enshrine a right to abortion in the constitution.
